Village Therapy plan

2nd Step

Heavy restrictions:

- Must work from home if you can
- Workforce bubble - must not work in multiple sites
- Full PPE

28/9

2nd Step

Heavy restrictions:

- Continue online therapy with current clients
- Small number of clients who have been without therapy to commence clinic sessions, with heavy infection control measures in place, including full PPE
- Workforce bubble - Clinicians who CAN NOT see any clients in the clinic due to other workplaces: Bridget, Gabby, Lisa and Kyle. Fiona unable to see clients in Sunbury.
- No offsite visits

3rd Step

Restrictions:

- Should work from home wherever possible
- Workforce bubble - Limited number of staff working at other sites

26/10

3rd Step

Restrictions:

- Continue online therapy wherever possible
- Workforce bubble - Team members who work at other sites able to see some pre-existing clients in the clinic who have been unable to participate in online therapy, using full PPE
- No off-site visits

Last Step

Restrictions:

- Should work from home wherever possible
- Workforce bubble - Limited number of staff working at other sites

23/11

Last Step

Restrictions:

- Continue online therapy wherever possible
- Workforce bubble - Close monitoring of team working at other sites. PPE according to Govt recommendations
- Limited off-site visits assessed for risk by the Management Team on a case-by-case basis.

COVID NORMAL

Subject to public health advice, when there are no new cases for 28 days and no active cases (state-wide) and no outbreaks of concern in other States and Territories

Open with a COVIDSAFE PLAN

- Gradual return to full clinic and off-site services
- Compliance with govt advice re distancing, mask-wearing, hand-hygiene and other infection controls

Village Therapy, Castlemaine, will also follow this plan, but according to the dates and steps of the Regional Victorian Roadmap.
